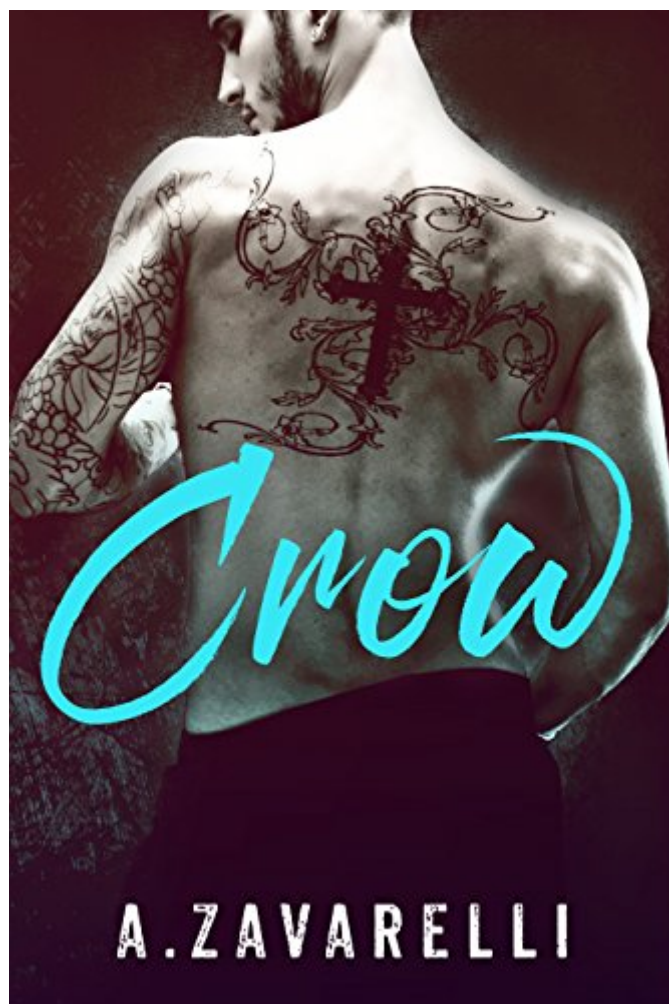


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# CROW (Boston Underworld Book 1)

She ends up spending half her time trying to get under his skin and the other half trying to fly under the radar. This book is well written and doesn't skip a detail.
